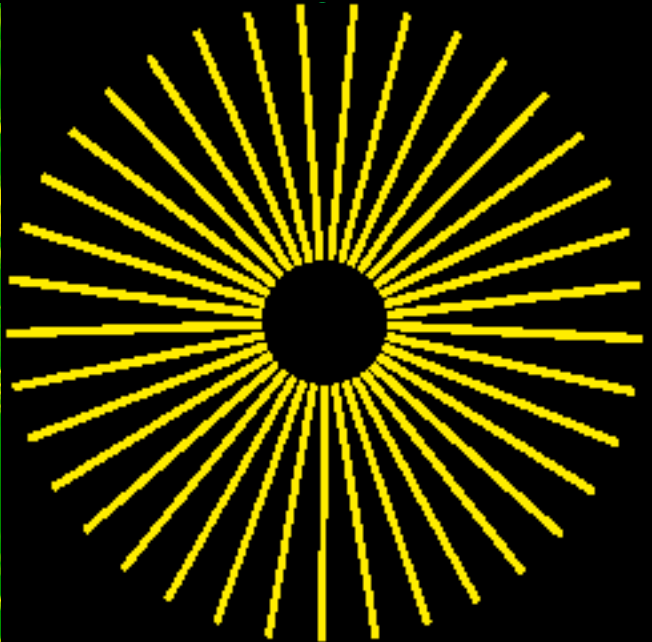

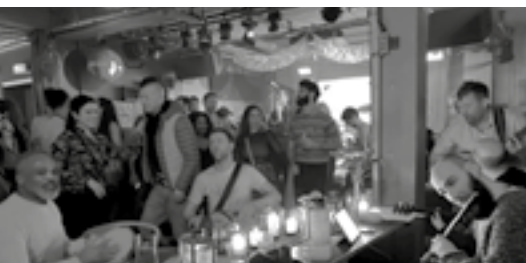

# WHAT IS A FRESH GIG?



**FRESH happens every Thursday during our open seasons & is a platform to bring you fresh new music, served up alongside a homecooked plant-based meal, board games, and candles.**

We do this because it can be hard to get people to take risks and come out to hear music they don't know yet, but all artists and musicians need to start somewhere, and there is such a huge amount of high-quality music out there just waiting to be heard.

These gigs are cosy, community driven, usually seated & more often than not gentle, listening type gigs – but not always! Expect to travel between jazz based music, alt-folk, experimental, electronic, singer-songwriter, and sometimes it's just genre defying.

If you buy the gig & dinner ticket, you get a 'one meal suits all' homecooked meal with your ticket. We usually cook the food from scratch and dinner is well suited to lovers of vegetables and wholesome cooking: it's usually something like a dahl, veggie chilli, tacos, roast veg or similar. Our baseline is vegan, sometimes with veggie options; we can cater for nut/gluten free meals, but nuts & gluten are used in the kitchen, so if you have serious allergies, please bear that in mind. If you would like to eat, you have to buy the tickets in advance, as we usually sell out & can't guarantee food once you arrive.

Doors are at 7PM, we aim to get dinner ready by 8PM and will bring it to you when it's ready... Music usually starts around 8PM-ish, sometimes later if it's a busy night for food (we are a tiny team!) and we aim to have the music finished by 10-10.15PM.

If you want to come to the gig only, it's £8 – as always, we are striving to make music available for everybody. We hope/think it's obvious that quality music and dinner for £11 is all about culture & community, and that these events cost us money... If you can afford to purchase a higher level 'Cobalt supporters' ticket and/or drinks at the bar, we appreciate the additional help towards costs very much.

# WHAT ELSE IS GOING ON AT COBALT?

Beyond our events, we've been working really hard at our partnerships, engagement and community development plans. We love sharing the bigger picture of what we're building, so here is a little snapshot of just some of the stuff that's on the go at the moment...



## Love International Takeovers

We got invited to do a Cobalt takeover boat party as part of the revered & very well loved Love International festival, and on Feb 14th (it was only fitting) you will find legendary DJ & Love Int founder Dave Harvey and Bristol underground legend Ellie Stokes at our place, on the decks and bringing a taste of the whole Love International brilliance to Cobalt.

## Digital development & membership projects

We're also developing an in-house ticketing platform with funding from NECA, which should save us around £20k a year in booking fees and make it much easier to share what's happening at Cobalt. Alongside this, we're working on a new 'Localship' (Aka membership) as a way to support the venue, protect diversity in the space, and give back to loyal supporters through early access, discounts, offers, and more.

## Tyneside Promoters Network

With support from the Tyneside Promoters Network (funded by NECA), we've secured some support towards bid-writer time – if we can get more funds in place, this will be a big step towards expanding our outreach work & it's good to be part of the network.



## Creative Central NCL X Cobalt

We are working with NCC & Creative Central NCL on the development of a very exciting new project due to launch this year. Here we are on site this morning chatting about progress. More info coming online soon... Keep your eyes peeled!



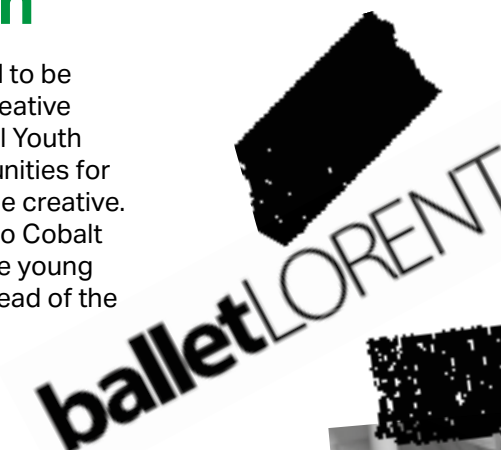
## PRS Foundation Talent Development Network

## A new exciting youth arts collaboration

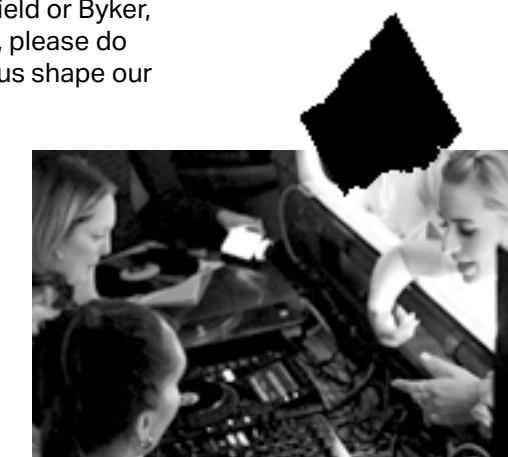
